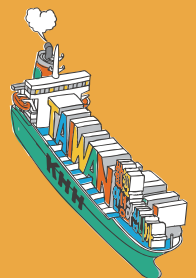

Born in Yongjing Township, Changhua County, Kevin is the ninth child of a farming family. Currently living in Berlin, his many literary awards include the Taiwan Literature Award's Annual Grand Prize, Ministry of Culture's Golden Tripod Award, first prize in the Lin Rong-San Literature Prize for Fiction, the Chiu Ko Annual Fiction Award, and Readmoo Readers' "Favorite Author" Award. Moreover, he is an author of a Kingstone Bookstore "Top-ten Influential Book". The publishing rights for his novel *Ghost Town* have been sold in over ten countries and reviewed / featured in *The New York Times* (USA), *Le Monde* (France), *Chosun Ilbo* (Korea), *Mainichi Shimbun* (Japan), *Corriere della Sera* (Italy), and *Helsingin Sanomat* (Finland), among others. Moreover, the Japanese and Vietnamese-language publishing rights for his *The Good People Upstairs* have been sold and *The 67<sup>th</sup> Pangolin* has already been published in Korea.

### Ghost Town 鬼地方

Kevin Chen's *Ghost Town*, set in the small central Taiwanese town of Yongjing, centers on Chen Tien-Hong—the youngest of seven siblings, born after parents desperate for a son. A gay man, he eventually escapes. Years later, after being released from prison in Berlin for killing his boyfriend, he returns to a desolate Yongjing. Through living and dead voices, the novel weaves family secrets, rural superstitions, identity struggles, and cultural clashes, blending a gothic family saga, coming-of-age story, and magical realism into a rich, compelling read.

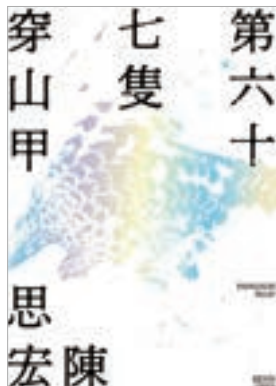
### The Good People Upstairs 樓上的好人

*The Good People Upstairs* is the final installment of Kevin Chen's "Summer Trilogy," set in a small town beside the railway in Taiwan. The story centers on a mother, Mei-li, who supports her family by running a hair salon, often hosting "good men" upstairs to make ends meet. After the eldest son disappears, the narrative shifts to the struggles of the eldest daughter and the youngest son, who both escape to Berlin, each carrying deep wounds. The novel alternates between past and present, Taiwan and Germany, blending multiple voices to explore family secrets, gender issues, and the decline of a town. Ultimately, it's a journey of healing for the siblings—only by confronting their past can they hope for renewal.

## The 67<sup>th</sup> Pangolin

*The 67<sup>th</sup> Pangolin* is Kevin Chen’s latest novel after his “Summer Trilogy.” The story follows “her,” a faded actress trapped in a troubled marriage, and “him,” a gay man exiled to Paris after being rejected by his family. Both were childhood friends who starred together in a mattress commercial, but grew up scarred by trauma and oppression. The novel begins with their reunion in Paris, weaving together multiple voices and shifting timeframes to explore childhood wounds, gender violence, and family secrets. Like pangolins, they protect themselves with emotional armor, yet ultimately find solace and redemption in each other—a poignant tale of survival, escape, and redefining intimacy.

## Tiong-Siong Ou | 胡長松



Born in 1973 in Kaohsiung City, Chang-Sung Hu (aka Tiong-Siong Ou) currently serves as Director of the Information Group at Taiwan Mobile. He began his literary career in 1995 and primarily writes novels that blend elements of modernism and Taiwanese realism. Since publishing his first the Taiwanese (Hokkien)-language novel in 2000, Hu has become one of today's most-recognized writers of contemporary Taiwanese literature. Hu has published two novels in Chinese, including *Requiem for the Boy of Chai Mountain* and *Skull Bar*, as well as six collections of short stories in Taiwanese, including *Gunshots*, *Under the Lighthouse*, *Big Harbor*, *Song of the Golden Island*, *The Resurrected*, and *The Phantom Voyage*. He has also published two collections of poetry in Taiwanese. Hu has received significant recognition for his work. His receipt of the Wu San-Lien Literary Award and the Golden Tripod Award for Literary Books marked the first time either award had been given to a literary work written in Taiwanese.

Born and raised in Kaohsiung, the author brings a “native realism” and geographical sense to these stories, giving them haunting authenticity.
